

Safety First Program for Juvenile Justice Involved Youth



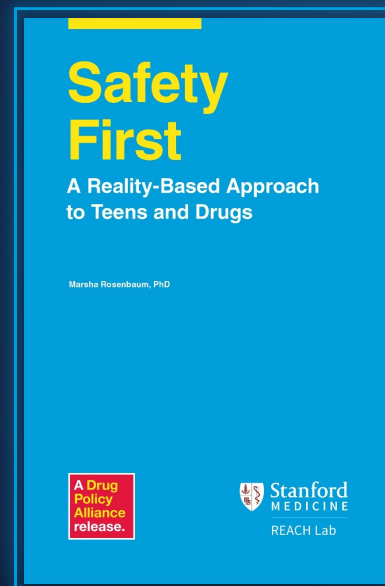
The Opioid Remediation Collaborative (ORC) of New Mexico has launched the Safety First program for youth involved in the Juvenile Justice system across our seven participating counties and their judicial districts!

The ONLINE Safety First curriculum is available to youth in the following counties: Catron, Hidalgo, Socorro, Sierra, Valencia, Guadalupe, Cibola, Grants, Luna, & the Village of Los Lunas (As well as any counties within Judicial Districts 4, 6, 7, and 13).



If drugs or alcohol played a role in the youth's referral to JJS, or it is agreed that an online 8-week class would be beneficial, a referral is made to the ORC by the JPO.
